Curriculum Overview

Below is a brief overview of what we are learning this term.

Maths - recognising numbers to 20, writing numbers to 20, counting forwards and backwards, sorting and classifying. Graphing and tallies. Simple addition and capacity. Subitising, 2D shapes and measurement revision

English - Talk 4 Writing (procedure and retell), Phonological Awareness, Heggerty, Early Literacy skills, Early Reading strategies, comprehension, news-telling

HASS - Past, present and future

Science - Chemistry (what things are made of and their properties)

Arts - Line, colour and texture

Music - Safe dance practices, dancing and musical instruments

Physical Education - Kidz 'N Sport (gross motor development) and Fundamental Movement Skills and Swimming Lessons

Health - Healthy eating, UR Strong program (social skills) and Zones of Regulation

Technology - iPad safety and rules. Practise using school apps
