Kindy Curriculum

This term, the Kindy themes will include the garden, minibeasts and community.

In Literacy, we will focus on comprehension skills (recalling information, retelling stories and Blank Level questions) and continue to consolidate the six pre-writing shapes. We will continue to focus on pre-reading skills including the parts of a book and on developing the children's fine motor skills to get their fingers ready for writing.

This term, we will begin Cracking the Code and Talk4Writing. Cracking the Code is a phonological awareness program that focuses on the development of children's oral language skills. This program will provide the foundational skills for students' future reading, spelling and writing. Talk4Writing is an approach that enables children to read and write independently for a variety of audiences and purposes within different subjects. At a Kindy level, we provide the foundation skills for this program. We create story maps and invent our own stories. We associate pictures and actions to key words in the story to help us retell the story. This approach provides students opportunities to develop crucial early reading and oral language skills.

In Maths, we will focus on measurement comparisons, subitising, patterning, number and counting skills, sorting, shapes and their attributes, positional language and graphing.

We will also continue with Library and Kidz n Sport.
