Kindy Curriculum

This term, the Kindy themes will include Self, Family, Emotions, Community and Easter. These themes will integrate our Literacy, Maths, Fine Motor, Science, Health and social skills this term.

In **Literacy**, we will focus on sound discrimination (environmental sounds, instrumental sounds and body percussion) and introduce the six pre-writing shapes. We will also focus on pre-reading skills including the parts of a book and on developing the children's fine motor skills to get their fingers ready for writing. Next term, we will begin *Cracking the Code*, a phonological awareness program that will focus on the development of children's oral language skills.

In **Maths**, we will focus on daily routines, shapes, sorting, positional language, numbers 1-10 (identification, counting, partitioning), ordering by size and the five counting principles. Mathematics is ingrained into the daily routines of Kindy, and the children will be exposed to numeracy skills in both explicit and incidental ways.

Library will commence for both classes in **Week 3**. The children will have the opportunity to choose from a range of book packs which include a set of reading comprehension activities. Your child must have a library bag to borrow from the library.



In Terms 1 & 2, the children will participate in **Kidz N' Sport**. This fantastic program develops the children's gross motor skills and coordination. The children will be exposed to a wide variety of sports. These sessions are timetabled for Tuesdays (Kindy Kangaroos) and Thursdays (Kindy Koalas).
