In this term, students from years 3 to 6 will begin training for our Faction Cross Country Carnival in Week 9.

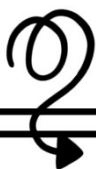
Cross Country is a long-distance event that allows students to run a set course through and around parts of the school.
