My focus on sport is making sure students give each sport and activity a go, ensuring students are challenging themselves with new skills and most importantly having fun.

Our Phys Ed lessons are centred around Moving, Learning and Understanding goals. Each term will focus on new goals and new skills

For the Junior School (year1/2), Term One will be all about learning and exploring fundamental movements skills.
