### Curriculum Overview

Below is a brief overview of what we are learning this term.

**Maths** - Number consolidation, place value, addition and subtraction, 3D shapes, length and mass, positional language, money recognition, patterning and time duration.

**English** - Talk 4 Writing (recount and information reports), continued spelling/phonics/sound knowledge, sentence structure, reading strategies, comprehension, sight words and adjectives

**HASS** - Geography-"Me on the Map!" Learning where we live in Australia and the World.

**Science** - Biology - the needs of living things.

**Arts** - Elements of Art ; shape, line, texture, mixed media art, colour.

**Music** - Safe dance practices, dancing and musical instruments

**Physical Education** - Fundamental Movement Skills.

**Health** - Introduction to Protective Behaviours. UR Strong and Zones of Regulation revision.

**Technology** - iPad safety and rules. Practise using school apps
