Curriculum Overview

This year we have been delivering the curriculum using the Early Years Learning framework as our guide and adding in more integration and play based experiences to our program.

Below is a brief overview of what we have learnt this term.

Maths - Number consolidation, addition, ordinal numbers, sorting and classifying, 2D and 3D shapes, capacity, patterning, Days of the week, Months of the year, Seasons.

English - Talk 4 Writing Program (narrative and procedure), Heggarty, continued letter and sound knowledge, decoding CVC (consonant vowel consonant) words and sentences, shared reading experiences, adjectives, verbs and comprehension skills.

HASS - Personal and Family History, ANZAC Day activities, NAIDOC activities

Science - Earth and Space - Weather and Seasons

Arts - Integrated arts and craft with focus on colour, texture, mixtures, sculpture and of course...creativity!

Music - Safe dance practices, dancing and musical instruments

Physical Education - Kidz n Sport, Fundamental Movement Skills and core strength, Variety of Obstacle courses.

Health -Looking after ourselves, Hygiene, Healthy Eating and Wellbeing.

Technology - iPad safety and rules. Introduction to using Seesaw, Draw and Tell, Chatterpix, Beebots, Scanning QR codes and Taking photos,
