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CURRICULUM

Writing

Bateman delivers a whole-school approach to writing using Talk for Writing. The writing produced in Term 1 was outstanding and gives us a great baseline to set goals for student growth throughout the year. Term 2 will see us complete 1 x 2 week block of Information Reports, 1 x 2 week block of Procedure Writing, 1 x 3 week block of Poetry and finishing off with Newspaper Reports.

Reading

This term will see us moving away from the whole-class novel study and moving directly into Reading sessions based on reading ability. Our reading comprehension will be integrated with our Talk for Writing program as well as reading sessions. Students will continue to work on explicit reading comprehension strategies and then apply these to a wider range of texts, both written and still image. Each class will rotate focusing on strategies over a two week period and learn apply these skills further.

Spelling

We will be continuing on with Bateman Primary's own spelling program for 2023. We will be using an evidence- based approach combining Heggerty Phonological Awareness program, along with a focus on sounds that will be run over a fortnight.

Maths

This year we will be running ability groups in our own classes. For Term 2, in Number and Algebra, we will be focusing on equivalence, addition and subtraction of fractions. In Measurement and Geometry, we will be focusing on area, volume, capacity and mass. In Statistics and Probability we will be focusing on probability.

Health

Term 2 will see us finishing off our whole-school URStrong program and completing our Sole Projects. We will also look at Brain Development and Choices.

HASS

In Term 2, we will focus on Civics & Citizenship and Geography. HASS will be delivered in two classes, Year 5 with Mr Scanlon and Year 6 with Mrs Pugh. HASS will be delivered through a combination of explicit teaching and project based-learning.

Digital Technologies

Digital Technologies will be completed in class groups. The beginning of the term will see us focus on Robotics and Coding.

Visual Art

Visual Art will be delivered to students as a whole 5/6 group and then completed in classrooms. All Year 5/6 students will complete the same project.

Kitchen Garden

Students will participate in Kitchen Garden sessions this term with the specialist teacher.
