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Curriculum

Writing

Bateman delivers a whole-school approach to writing using Talk for Writing. The writing produced throughout the year has been outstanding and gives us a great baseline to set goals for student growth in Term 4. Term 4 will see us complete a Film Study, we will investigate Biographies and finish off the year with Poetry.

Reading

This term will see us looking at Book Genres, students will get to explore each of the different genres when reading and critically respond to the material. Our reading comprehension will be integrated with our Talk for Writing program as well as reading sessions. Students will continue to work on explicit reading comprehension strategies and then apply these to a wider range of texts, both written and still image.

Spelling & Grammar

This term we are broadening our spelling program to focus on a range of English language features to further prepare the students for a variety of material they will encounter in high school.

Maths

For Term 4, we will continue with Math groups. In Number and Algebra, we will be focusing on Money. In Measurement and Geometry, we will be focusing on Mass, Coordinates & Cartesian Planes and Scale & Ratio.

Health

Term 4 will see us looking into Healthy & Active Lifestyles and what it means to make healthy choices around food and being active in our everyday lives.

HASS

This term, we will look at Economics, and giving them an awareness with consumer choice, entrepreneurship and the needs and wants of local and wider businesses.

Design and Technologies

Design this term, sees us integrating these skills we are learning in Economics to design and create sustainable shoes and building and construction.

Visual Art will be delivered to students as a whole Year 6 group and then completed in classrooms. All Year 6 students will complete the same project and is integrated throughout our learning journey.
